In consideration of the participation in activities of FIRST Robotics, membership on teams organized, sponsored or sanctioned by FIRST Robotics, and participation in competitions, seminars, clinics, exhibitions, programs or appearances for, on behalf of or in representation of FIRST Robotics Robo Riot Team 3418,

In addition to the foregoing, but not by way of limitation, the following could result in disciplinary proceedings:
 - Transporting, possession, or unauthorized use of alcoholic beverages.
 - Any physical damage to facilities, equipment, furnishings, or loss of items in a room where I am lodged, which will be paid for by those individuals assigned to the room in which the damage or loss occurs, including destruction of property (including that caused by horseplay, fighting, or willful misconduct etc.).
 - Any act considered to be an offense under federal, state, or local laws or the organizer of an event in which I participate.
 - Misconduct (*i.e.*, inappropriate horseplay, theft, fighting, etc.).
